Where: Camping, Automotive Mechanics Merit Badge and Cub Scout activities at Mill Creek Fire Company Grounds. Car show and Museum Tour at Swigart Museum.

Pre-requisite for Automotive Mechanics Merit Badge: Scouts must complete one of the following under Requirement 11 on their own: Requirement 11a, 11b or 11d. Requirement 11c will be completed on site.

What to Bring: Cub Scouts, Scouts and Venturers should bring and wear their Class A uniform during Flags, Saturday Evening Campfire and Sunday Morning Religious Service. Troops are encouraged to do a No Cook breakfast and lunch on Saturday. All American Pizza & Subs and Dominoes will deliver to Camporee site.

Scouts and Venture Crews will get to experience a tour of Swigart Museum on Saturday or Sunday (their choice) and a Saturday morning car show. Then, back at Mill Creek Fire Co. they will get the chance to earn Automotive Maintenance Merit Badge. Plus enjoy fellowship & fun!

Cub Scouts come enjoy some fun, a tour of the museum, check out the car show and then in the afternoon design some cars, build and ride in cub cars, and design and set off bottle rockets. A great time for all. Come for the weekend or just for Saturday the cost is still \$5 per participant. Cub Scout activities are from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
