Spring Camporee and First Aid Meet

April 30, May 1 & 2, 2021

\$8.00 per Scout or Adult – Camporee and First Aid Meet

\$5.00 per Scout or Adult – First Aid Meet ONLY

We are required to pre-screen everyone (visitors and attendees) coming to the Camporee for COVID-19. Pre-screening will be held **Friday evening from 5pm-7pm** at the **Smith Transport parking lot prior to anyone arriving at Camp Anderson.** For those who will arrive after 7:00 PM or on Saturday morning, you still need to COVID Pre-Screen and there will be reserved parking spaces at Camp Anderson along VanScoyoc Hollow Road that you will park in. Someone will come to your car and give you instructions. Masks and social distancing will be enforced throughout the weekend. Please make sure your troop has masks and hand sanitizer as we cannot provide. The COVID Protocols and Screening information for this event are at the end of this packet. Please read them.

After pre-screening, you will be permitted to drive to your camp site and set up camp. Please to the maximum extent possible park in the Upper Lot if you cannot park at your campsite, as the area along VanScoyoc Hollow Road beside the barn will be used for after-hours COVID Pre-Screening, and the area in front of the Dining Hall will be reserved for post-screening handicapped use and activities. Camping in the field will be permitted **except** where indicated by marking tape. Pavilions may be used but keep in mind, the pavilions will need to be used for classrooms for the First Aid Meet so they must be clear by 8:00 AM Saturday Morning. There will be a patrol leader meeting at 8:30 PM Friday Night on the porch at the Dining Hall for registration/instructions.

Your \$8.00 registration fee will register you for BOTH the Spring Camporee and the First Aid Meet. Use Form Numbers (1) and (2) in this packet to register. Please bring these forms already filled out and signed to event registration.

Units wishing only to participate in the First Aid Meet on Saturday from 8:00 AM to Noon may register on Saturday morning for \$5.00 per Scout or Adult. Use Form Numbers (3) and (4) in this packet to register. You will not be permitted to stay the rest of the weekend if you register for the First Aid Meet only.

Restrooms will be limited to the bath house across the creek or the outhouses. Buildings are to remain off limits except in case of severe weather. The Event First Aid Station will be at the Memorial Lodge. Campfires are permitted, but remember to Leave No Trace! We are asking you to bring 1 – 2 empty gallon jugs; this will be to collect water for fire safety. **All activities will go on, rain or shine so be prepared.**

Saturday morning from 9:00 AM to Noon will be the Boy Scout First Aid Meet. Registration for the First Aid Meet will start at 8:00 AM Saturday at the Dining Hall. For Saturday morning arrivals, COVID-19 pre-screening will take place beginning at 7:45 AM. **Please pass through the COVID-19 pre-screening before registering your unit.** Saturday afternoon will be free time for you to spend with your troop; fish, if you have gear; or play games in site. Saturday evening at 5:30, meet at the dining hall for an evening of organized chaos. **Please wear your grungy clothes and shoes for this activity and rain poncho, if needed.**

First Aid Meet Information:

All source material for the challenges will be from the Boy Scout Handbook (latest revision) and the First Aid Merit Badge Pamphlet (latest revision). The required list of equipment to bring is listed on Page 109 of the Boy Scout Handbook.

Firewood: There are several options for Troops to have firewood at the Camporee. Any fires using wood that contains nails must be in established fire locations only. **NO exceptions.**

Troops may cut wood from the woods from any downed tree for fire wood at no cost. Follow all safety guidelines while cutting.

Troops may use any of the pallet lumber (which does contain nails) that is available on site for free. Plan on gathering it from the upper parking lot, cutting or breaking it up and taking it to your campsite.

Troops may purchase pre-cut and split wood from one of the existing stock piles. Rate schedules are posted at the camp and online. Precut stockpiles are identified by being tarped, so please do not take firewood from a tarped pile unless you arrange to pay for it.

You may bring your own firewood with you to camp.

Vehicles In Camp: Please do not drive any vehicles into an area that is taped off. In particular the road up to the rifle range will be off limits due to the wet conditions for this event.

Trading Post: There may be a trading post at the camporee with pre-packaged snacks only.

Please be aware that you need to also watch for ticks, and perform a self-check as often as possible during the weekend.

The most important thing about this weekend is to safely HAVE FUN!

Chief Logan District Spring Camporee & First Aid Meet 2021
THIS INFORMATION MUST BE SHARED WITH ALL ATTENDEES AND

COVID PRE-SCREENINGS WILL BE CONDUCTED AS FOLLOWS:

FRIDAY NIGHT – 5:00 TO 7:00 PM – SMITH TRANSPORT PARKING LOT

AFTER 7:00 PM FRIDAY NIGHT AND SATURDAY MORNING STARTING AT 7:00
AM – PARKING AREA ALONG VANSCHOYOC HOLLOW ROAD BESIDE THE BARN

**ALL THOSE ARRIVING MUST BE PRE-SCREENED FOR COVID AND RECEIVE A
WRISTBAND BEFORE GOING ANYWHERE ELSE ON THE CAMP ANDERSON
PROPERTY. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Medical Form A and B: Current Medical Forms are required.

1. Medical Form A & B is required for Scouts, Leaders and Parents attending Camporee.
2. Medical Form A & B is required for Scouts attending the First Aid Meet.
3. Scoutmaster or Adult MUST sign the Unit Registration Form (Form 1 or Form 3 in the packet) certifying possession of the proper medical forms.

COVID Policies for the Camporee and First Aid Meet:

1. **If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, Stay Home!**
2. All COVID policies in place by Local, PA, and CDC or recommended guidelines will be followed. Follow all BSA protocols for COVID.
3. Troop and/or the Patrol are responsible for their Facemasks and Hand Sanitizer.
4. Face Masks must be worn at all times, unless medically exempt.
5. Wash hands frequently or use hand sanitizer.
6. Please stay in your Patrol while out of your campsite.
7. Maintain the required 6' distance from others that are not in your Patrol.
8. No visitors in camp, unless out of necessity. Visitors must have a COVID Pre-Screening before entering any Campsites, Dining Hall Area, or Camporee Area. If you arriving after 7:00 PM Friday Night or any time Saturday, please park in the parking area alongside VanSchoyoc Hollow Road beside the barn. Someone will come to your vehicle and pre-screen you and give you a wristband.

9. Parents are permitted to attend the First Aid Meet. They must have a health screening as in Item No. 8 above.
10. An isolation area for persons with COVID symptoms will be made available until parents pick up their scout. Parent's will be called first. The Health Officer will remain with the Scout or Scouter until parent's arrive.
11. While at the Camporee or First Aid Meet if you experience any COVID symptoms report to the back porch of Memorial Lodge. Follow Instructions on the door. The Patrol should remain in campsite until the Health Team clears the Patrol.

COVID Pre-Screening Procedures:

All Campers, Parents/Siblings taking supplies to Campsites, and the First Aid Meet attendees must be COVID Pre-Screened.

1. COVID-related questions will be asked.
2. Temperature will be taken.
3. If you have a fever over 100.0°F you will be sent home.
4. After Health Screening you may proceed to your campsite.
5. Do not enter any campsites without your Temperature and Health Check Wristband.

Parking after COVID Pre-Screening:

Campers with Campsites above the Dining Hall either side of creek:

1. Park in the Upper Lot and in your campsite to the maximum extent possible. This includes any trailer parking.

Campers with campsites below Dining Hall either side of creek:

1. Park at your campsite to the maximum extent possible. This includes any trailer parking. Please do not park directly in front of the Dining Hall. Please reserve the area beside the barn along VanScoyoc Hollow Road for those needing an after-hours COVID Pre-Screening.

Scout Drop-off and or Parents/Siblings going to campsites with supplies but not staying:

1. Get your COVID Pre-Screening:
 - a. Between 5:00 and 7:00 PM Friday Night: Screenings will be done at the Smith Transport Parking Lot.
 - b. After 7:00 PM Friday Night: Screenings will be done in the parking area along VanScoyoc Hollow Road beside the barn. Please do not park directly in front of the Dining Hall.
 - c. After 7:00 AM Saturday Morning: Screenings will be done in the parking area along VanScoyoc Hollow Road beside the barn. Please do not park directly in front of the Dining Hall.
2. Parents must go to COVID Pre-Screenings with their Scout.
3. If a parent and/or sibling(s) is going to the campsite with supplies they must also have a COVID Pre-Screening.
4. After COVID Pre-Screening you may proceed to the campsite.

Arrivals after 7:00 PM Friday Who Are Staying Over:

1. Park in the dining hall area for late arrivals.
2. Report directly to the porch area designated "Late Arrival Area."
3. Parents must go to Health Screenings with their Scout.
4. After Health Screening you may proceed to the campsite.

All Arrivals Saturday Morning:

1. Park in the area beside the barn along VanScoyoc Hollow Road for your COVID Pre-Screening. Parents must go to COVID Pre-Screenings with their Scout. COVID Pre-Screenings will begin at 7:00 AM.
2. If a parent and or siblings is going to the First Aid Meet or the campsite with supplies they must also have a COVID Pre-Screening.
3. Temperature will be taken and asked COVID-related questions. If you have a fever over 100.0 you will be sent home.
4. Report to the Dining Hall for First Aid Meet Check-in/Registration.
5. Do not enter any campsites without your Temperature and Health Check Wristband.

Don't Forget that your Patrol and Troop Check-in is still required at the Dining Hall!
